INITIAL CASE ORDER

Issued : March 14, 2022

1. On February 8, 2022, the FCC’s Media Bureau released a Hearing Designation Order and Notice of Opportunity for Hearing in the above-captioned mater.¹ As directed by that order, and pursuant to section 1.221(c) of the Commission’s rules, 47 CFR § 1.221(c), counsel for Snake River Radio filed an appearance in this hearing proceeding on February 28, 2022.²

2. An initial status conference will be conducted virtually on **Thursday, March 31, 2022, at 10:00 AM** via an online platform accessible to all parties.³ On or before **March 28, 2022**, the parties shall submit the following information:

- A proposed schedule for this case, including pre-hearing and post-hearing matters;
- A description of the type of discovery anticipated, if any; and
- A description of expected pre-hearing motions, including motions for protective orders.

3. This proceeding will be conducted pursuant to the written hearing procedures codified at sections 1.370 through 1.377 of the Commission’s rules.⁴ As the proposed schedules will be discussed during the initial status conference, no written pleadings responsive to the parties’ scheduling submissions will be entertained.

4. Accordingly, **IT IS ORDERED** that the initial status conference in this matter will be held on **March 31, 2022, commencing at 10:00 a.m.**, at which a hearing schedule shall be set. All subsequent oral conferences, if needed, shall be conducted in this same manner unless otherwise directed.

5. **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the parties shall submit the information required above on or before **March 28, 2022**. All written submissions in this proceeding shall be filed using the Commission’s Electronic Comment Filing System (ECFS) by 11:59 PM Eastern Time on the filing date.


