**INITIAL CASE ORDER**

**Issued : March 18, 2022**

**Released: March 18, 2022**

1. On February 23, 2022, the FCC’s Media Bureau released a Hearing Designation Order, Notice of Opportunity for Hearing, and Notice of Apparent Liability for Forfeiture in the above-captioned matter.<sup>1</sup> As directed by that order, and pursuant to section 1.221(c) of the Commission’s rules, 47 CFR § 1.221(c), counsel for the Marion Education Exchange filed an appearance in this hearing proceeding on March 14, 2022.<sup>2</sup>

2. An initial status conference will be conducted virtually on **Wednesday, April 20, 2022, at 10:00 AM** via an online platform accessible to all parties.<sup>3</sup> On or before **April 14, 2022**, the parties shall submit the following information:

- A proposed schedule for this case;
- A description of the type of discovery anticipated, if any; and
- A description of expected pre-hearing motions, if any.

3. Accordingly, **IT IS ORDERED** that the initial status conference in this matter will be held virtually on **April 20, 2022, commencing at 10:00 a.m.**, at which a hearing schedule shall be set. All subsequent oral conferences, if needed, shall be conducted in this same manner unless otherwise directed.

4. **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the parties shall submit the information required above on or before **April 14, 2022**. All written submissions in this proceeding shall be filed using the Commission’s Electronic Comment Filing System (ECFS) by 11:59 PM Eastern Time on the filing date.
