ORDER



1. This order temporarily suspends the filing deadlines for written hearing submissions in the above-captioned proceeding until further notice. A brief suspension is necessary to allow the Presiding Judge to consider issues raised by the FCC's Enforcement Bureau in its Emergency Motion to Strike filed on November 1, 2022.¹ Pursuant to section 1.294(b) of the Commission's rules, 47 CFR § 1.294(b), Snake River Radio's response to the Emergency Motion to Strike is due on or before November 7, 2022. As a result of this suspension of filing deadlines, Snake River Radio's Affirmative Case in this proceeding is not due today as originally scheduled. The Presiding Judge will issue a revised written hearing schedule upon disposition of the Emergency Motion to Strike.

2. Accordingly, **IT IS ORDERED** that the deadlines for written hearing submissions in this proceeding established by the Presiding Judge in her order of April 1, 2022, FCC 22M-08, **ARE SUSPENDED** until further notice.²
